Weak Areas Identified in


1. Students' General Feedback

Students were asked to respond to 10 parameters on the college's teaching, learning, and evaluation quality. Parameters for which students provided a response percentage of 5% or more in the Poor category were analyzed and the following actions were taken:

- i. **Time management:** 5% of students responded Poor for the parameter- time management. Last year the percentage was 5.6%, which has declined slightly as teachers arranged extra classes for weak students. Mentor-Mentee sessions were arranged by all departments to address time management issues while revising the syllabus and attempting papers in university examination.

2. Teacher's Feedback

Teachers were asked to respond to 11 parameters about curriculum, resources, and administrative support. There was not even a single parameter for which teachers provided a response percentage, 5% or more in the Poor category. As planned in the previous session, the college started 10 Value Added Courses to bridge the gap between academia and industry. Faculty Development Programme- National Education Policy-2020 (Dec 23, 2023) and Capacity Building Programmes on Information Literacy (Dec 26, 2023); How to generate and use Google Scholar Profile for Research Findings (Jan 18, 2024) and Patent Filing- Protecting Ideas, Empowering Innovations (April 9, 2024) were organized to cover bottlenecks in the faculty performance and growth.
